OPERATIONS DIVISION

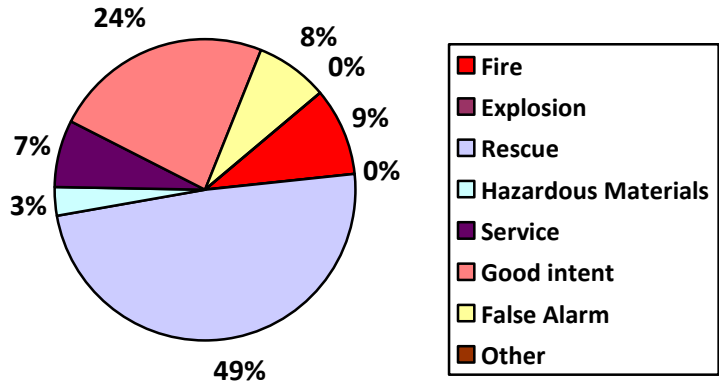
Incident Activity

There were 65 emergency fire responses during March (196 YTD). Included were the following: 0 structure fires, 2 vehicle fires, 7 natural cover fires and 3 rubbish/trash fires.

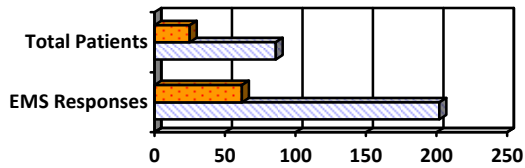
There were 156 (479 YTD) vehicle responses during March.

Estimated fire loss during March was \$8,100.

The District's 7-minute response goal for fire calls in March was met with 85.5% effectiveness.
