**OPERATIONS DIVISION**

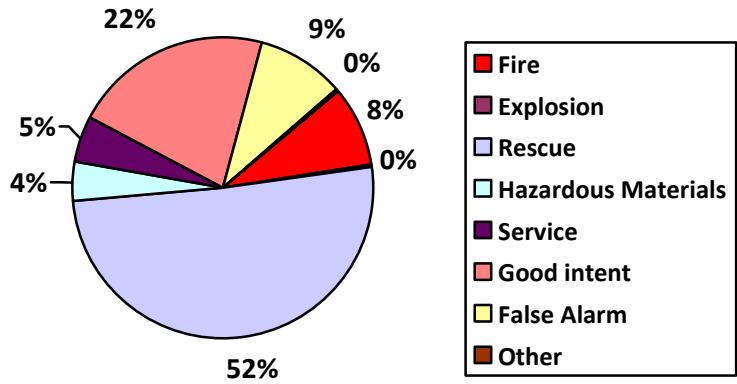
**Incident Activity**

There were 751 emergency fire responses during 2007. Included were the following: 45 structure fires, 18 motor vehicle fire and 67 natural cover/rubbish fires.

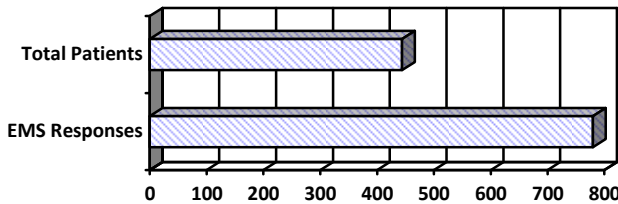
There were 1,991 vehicle responses during 2007.

Estimated fire loss during 2007 was \$1,689,125.

The District's 7-minute response goal for fire calls in 2007 was met with 81% effectiveness.

**TRAINING DIVISION**

There were 15,031 man-hours of training reported for 2007. Key subject matter included: Monthly Competencies, Drivers Certification, EMS CEU's, Live Burns, Leadership and Terrorism/Hazardous Materials. Ninety (90) different certifications were issued to fifty-four individuals. Seventeen employees attended external training sessions, ranging from one day to fourteen days.
