OPERATIONAL ACTIVITIES

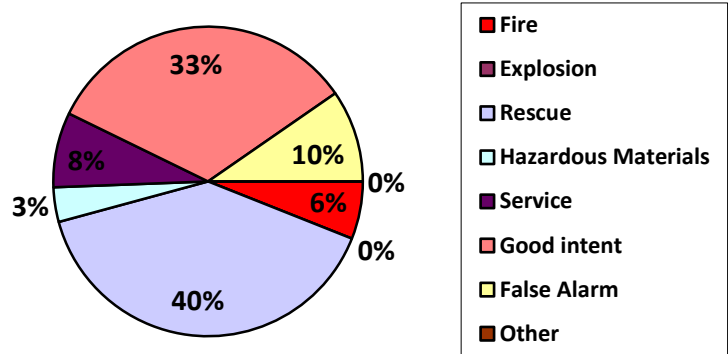
Incidents

There were 100 emergency fire responses during May (490 YTD). Included were the following: 4 structure fires, 1 vehicle fires, 0 equipment fires and 5 rubbish/natural cover fires.

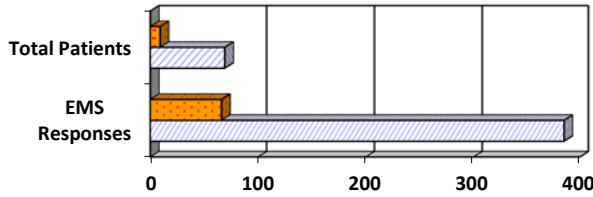
There were 171 (865 YTD) Southern Platte vehicle on scene responses during May.

Estimated fire loss during May was \$307,000.

The District's 7-minute response goal for fire calls in May was met with 88.6% effectiveness.
