OPERATIONS DIVISION

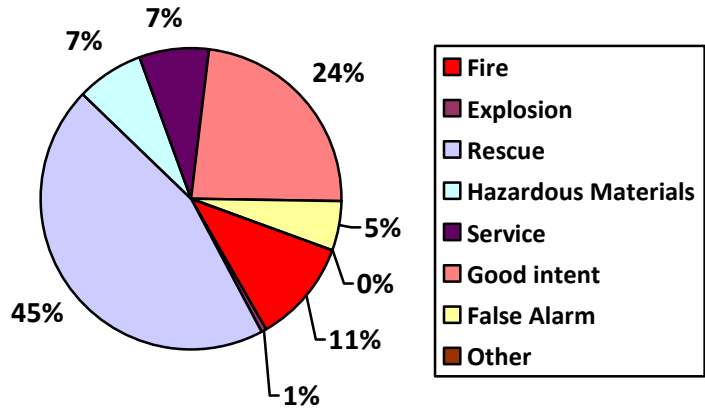
Incident Activity

There were 75 emergency fire responses during April (224 YTD). Included were the following: 5 structure fires, 1 vehicle fires, 7 natural cover/rubbish fires and 2 outside fires.

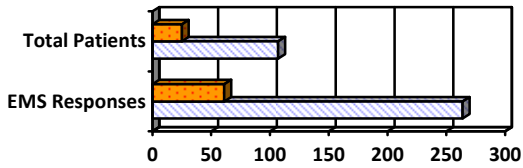
There were 188 (600 YTD) vehicle responses during April.

Estimated fire loss during April was \$175,000.

The District's 7-minute response goal for fire calls in April was met with 81.6% effectiveness.
